Every few months we will be offering a new book from a different specialty within cardiology that members will have the chance of winning.

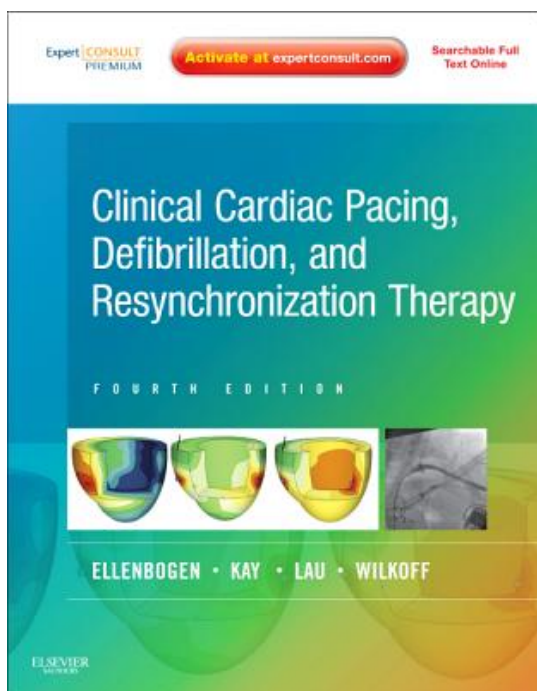

SCT CSANZ FELLOWSHIP (NZ)

SCT is providing 4 fellowships for the 'mini CSANZ' conference registration up to a maximum of \$500.

SCT is providing 2 fellowships for the attendance of CSANZ on the Gold Coast, Australia up to a maximum of \$1000.

Funding is available for either the CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting in New Zealand or Australia.

Conditions –

Applications will be discussed at the April SCT Council meeting. Applicants will be advised within 2 weeks of the outcome of their application.

If accepted, you will be required to send a copy of your conference registration form and original receipts for reimbursement to a maximum of \$500 for the 'mini CSANZ' and up to a maximum of \$1000 for the Australia CSANZ meeting.
